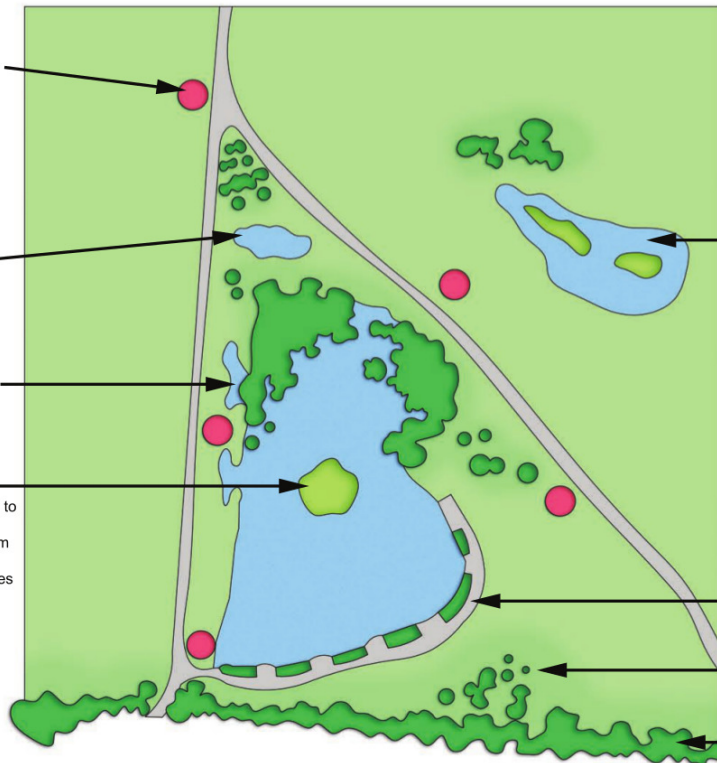


Shallow scrapes created in existing low lying wet areas to provide fish-free refuges for amphibians



Shallow backwaters attached to main pond, to give shelter to amphibians

Floating reed bed / habitat island helps to aerate the water and remove nutrients from the water and protected nesting sites



Large shallow seasonal pond/wetland with islands, for ground nesting birds. Created in existing wet areas



Access path for fishing and shore stabilised by spiling and stone packing

Regenerating scrub area to provide shelter and food for birds
