

# Market Day Event

The Market Day is a great opportunity for people who need extra support, along with their Carers and Families, to be able to find out what is available in North Tyneside. It is also a great opportunity for people who provide services to showcase what they have to offer, and to find out what kind of support people would like to access.

## Who is the event for?

This event is for anyone who has a learning disability and/or physical disability, their families and carers. It is identified that some people attending the event will receive a personal budget and would like to know where to spend it. Other people attending may not be in receipt of a personal budget but would like to access certain provision e.g. sport classes, assistive technology.

## Who will the providers be?

Providers will include a range of organisations who offer 1 to 1 support, activities, community based classes and leisure facilities. In addition, Providers will include private companies, voluntary and community organisations, and the Local Authority.

For those providers and agencies that come into contact with children and young people with additional needs aged 14 – 25 and their families / carers, this is also an opportunity to support them with their Transition plans through the sharing of information of what your service or agency provides.
